- have deep personal integrity, most clearly seen in gracious humility.
- be both highly relational and gifted in leading large groups of people.
- thrive in a low-control environment.

Role

Work alongside the senior minister and other assistant minister in a co-pastoring leadership model, considering every aspect of the life of the church.

In addition to this general and strategic leadership role, there are three key responsibilities:

1. The pastoring and leadership of our evening service.
2. Oversight of our integration pathways, helping new people become partners in the ministry of the gospel at Central.
3. Responsibility for our three weekly church services, ensuring that they are Christ-centred, well run, coherent times of worship.

Qualifications and Experience

The successful candidate will have a degree-level qualification from a reformed evangelical theological college.

They will also have a proven track record of leading ministry teams, experience with congregational oversight and child safety standards.
